Dear Prayer Partners,

February passed by quickly. It has also brought some changes to the climate. The weather is a little cooler, and we get rain showers occasionally as we transition from the dry season to the rainy season. Our Wednesday Bible studies continue to go well. There are usually six to eight in attendance. Attendance at the Sunday service has dropped somewhat this past month, as February marks the start of the new school term, and many of the students also board at the schools they attend. The last couple of weeks, we have also been discussing ways the church can raise funds to finish construction of the church building. Armstrong presented this to the church not only as a means to complete the construction but also for the members to grow and develop themselves and their living conditions. This last Sunday, the church decided on a project for which there is a steady market in this area, and a reasonable income can be made.

Please be in prayer for Dominic. He is from a nearby village in which he is the only believer. He is handicapped, making it difficult for him to provide for his children. A couple of weeks ago, someone in the village accused him of practicing witchcraft. He was able to get out of the village before the villagers were organized to kill him. Marchelo helped rescue him and has been trying to get the police to help resolve the situation. Pray specifically for God to continue to supply his needs, resolve the issue in his village, and for these people to be opened to the Gospel. Dominic has been living with Marchelo, but spent a couple of days preaching in a village by the Nile River. When he returned, he told me a couple of people responded to the Gospel message and were saved. God is at work here, and Satan is seeking to fight against it.

As I mentioned in the last update, the translation team gave me a list of difficult words they want to double-check for consistency in their translation. I finished compiling a list of references for these words, and it came to 6,100 entries. We will start checking this in the next week or two, once the final revisions for tone markings, punctuation, and spelling are complete. The remaining nine books of the New Testament are being back-translated for our translation analysis check. Once these are completed and typed up, we will send the NT to our outside consultants for a final review of accuracy. The work is tedious some days, but it is exciting to see the end in sight! I have returned to creating the translation worksheets for the Old Testament. I Samuel is completed, and II Samuel is nearly so. Thirty-eight percent of the Old Testament is ready for the team to begin translating. Thank you for your continued prayers and support! There are regular health needs and various issues that arise here for which we need God's strength and enablement.
