Dear Prayer Partners,

Over the past few days, I have heard a few people express their desire to have the completed Madi New Testament soon or ask why the translation is taking so long to complete. I am always encouraged to hear this desire of believers to have the Bible in their own language. We are excited to be nearing the completion of the New Testament. Just over half of the difficult words have been checked for consistency and accuracy. Tones are being marked on necessary words. These are the two biggest tasks currently. I mentioned in the last update that I was moving the work into Paratext software. This has really accelerated the work as everyone now has access to the master copy and can make necessary edits. It is also giving me an active role in the work by formatting the text, checking punctuation and capitalization, and flagging potential issues. We appreciate your prayers as we work through these final details!

I preached three of the Sundays in May. I have been preaching through Ephesians and am currently in chapter four. At the end of one of the services, I was asked to do the dedication service for a baby who was recently born to a couple in the church. This was an interesting first-time experience! (See photo below.)

Around the middle of May, there was an outbreak of Ebola in a province of the Democratic Republic of the Congo bordering northwest Uganda. So far, there have been only a handful of cases in Uganda and none in my town of Adjumani. There is a possibility that schools will be closed starting this Friday, along with other restrictions, to prevent the disease from spreading further. Please be praying for those areas that are suffering from Ebola and for it to be contained and stopped.

I got some grass and had it planted in my yard. This variety of grass is supposed to remain green through the dry season, which will help reduce the amount of dust when the weather is dry. I saw some of the plants were scorched, but I just need to wait for the others to take root and spread throughout the yard. I finally purchased a motorcycle this last week. It is exciting to be driving on the left side of the road with very minimal enforcement of the traffic laws! One never knows if the person turning will slow down or even look before entering traffic. Thank you for your prayers and support!
