Dear Prayer Partners,

The last couple of months have been productive. Early in May, I drove to Clearwater, Florida, for a meeting and was able to briefly visit my sister in Deltona. Josiah Mawia, another deputation missionary with BWM, was at this same meeting, and we drove back to Wisconsin together. We left at 5:30 in the morning Eastern Time and made it back to Milwaukee at 12:30 that night Central Time. In June, I attended the WorldView staff retreat and was greatly blessed by the fellowship with others involved in Bible translation. Please pray for each of our translation projects, as Satan understands the power God's word has when it is in the language of the common man and is actively opposing these translations in various ways.

I am asking for a particular prayer for wisdom regarding setting a departure date to head to Uganda. I have been hesitant to do so up until now as I would have preferred to be at 100% support. However, I have been sensing recently that God would have me step out in faith and set that departure date and trust Him to supply the final 6% of the support that I still need. A major reason for this is due to the timing of the Madi translation, which is in the final checks of the New Testament, and Marchelo has expressed their need for me to be there working alongside them. I also need to be there soon to teach Hebrew, as we are nearly ready to transition to translating the Old Testament. Please pray that God would bring in the final 6% in the next couple of months and that I would have wisdom in these next few days regarding setting a departure date.

I have been making significant progress in checking the back translation of Matthew for the Madi translation. I have just a couple chapters left to check. I am just waiting for David to send me the final files that did not upload when he sent the rest of them. They have finished the group checks of Revelation and should be sending those to me soon. I also finished creating the translation worksheets for Leviticus and will be moving onto Numbers this week. I am thankful to report that my work permit for residency in Uganda has been approved!

My youngest sibling graduated from high school, and I was able to be at his graduation reception in June. While I was home, I worked on upgrading some of the electrical components on my grandparent's place. I installed a safety switch to control the power from the house to all of the outbuildings. I moved the post, to which the power line was attached, from the middle of the garage roof to the side of the garage as it was allowing water to get inside the garage (photo below). I also installed conduit and ran new wires for the yard light out back as well as the wellhouse. I will finish hooking up the yard light the next time I am home. Serving the Lord,
