Dear Prayer Partners,

A lot has happened since I sent out my last update in December. December began with a very unique opportunity. The chaplain for a day center program in Milwaukee contacted my church to see if someone could hold a Bible study for the elderly and special needs folks attending. I shared the Christmas story and bridged from that into the Gospel. I had good interactions with the folks there, and the person in charge expressed an interest in having us return. They have just recently contacted us again and want someone to come again on a monthly basis to continue holding Bible studies. Please pray that these precious souls will be saved and that their family members will also be reached with the Gospel. My schedule will not allow me to continue with the Bible studies, but I am thankful to see this door open in my area and that others are able to step in and fill this need.

I spent the latter part of December with my family in Iowa. It was fun to hunt and trap once again with my dad and brothers. We were much more prepared for the trapping season this year and dried all the fur that we caught. We then sold the fur to a fur buyer who came through our area on December 14. My brothers kept the trapline running during the frequent times I was gone, and we have had a tremendous season catching coyote, racoon, opossum, skunk, muskrat, beaver, otter, and mink. We filled all our deer tags this year and got three coyotes while deer hunting.

My parent's pastor in lowa asked me to preach the nursing home service for him while he was out of town. My younger sister came along to play the piano for me, and we had a wonderful time with the folks there. I have also finished checking the back translations of 1 and 2 Peter and have sent them to the translators to be checked and corrected. The next books for me to check are Jude and then Matthew.

I am very thankful to report that more **support** has come in, and I am **currently at 93.8%!** I also want to thank each one who has given towards my **outfit and passage** need! I **currently have 13.8%** of the \$20,978 that I need to move to Uganda, find a place and furnish it, and find suitable transportation. I have been making good progress in sorting and packing things for the move and getting my other affairs in order stateside. The next step is to start preparing for the logistics of getting settled in Uganda!
